

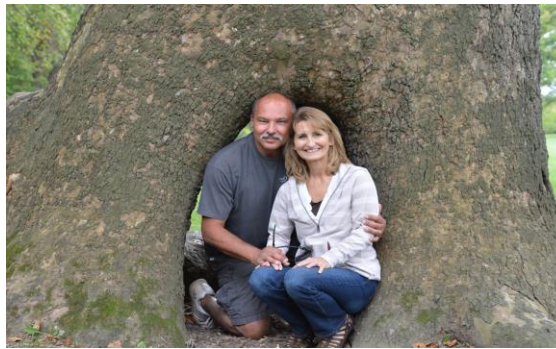
WHAT IS SEARCH?

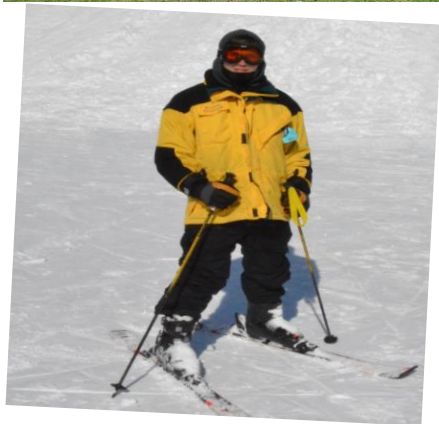

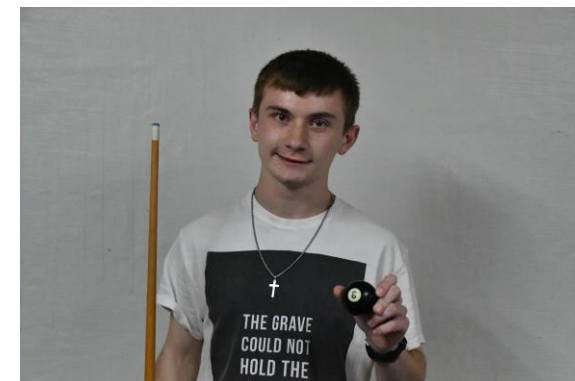
